Animal welfare weekend camps are meant for 9-14 year old children who are interested in animal care and welfare. The program of the weekend includes discussions and activities about animal welfare issues in general and about specific animal species matters that are particularly interesting to the children, participation in all the farm activities, like feeding the shelter animals, grooming ponies and dogs and milking the cows. If the children want, they can also do little pony riding. Food is vegetarian with a taste of camping and adventure (e.g. pancakes cooked on fire for dinner, picnic to the riverside on horseback).

Children are accommodated on the Hill View Farm Animal Refuge in a small guest-cottage with one bedroom and a bathroom with shower (hot water) and seat toilet. A volunteer “big-sister” stays in the same room to help in any needs and the IPAN staff are available on the farm.

We recommend booking the weekend camp one month ahead. Due to limited space available in the guest-cottage we can only take two children participating at a time.
